FISCAL YEAR 2019 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

KOMU 8 & Mid-Missouri's CW served as the Title Sponsor for our Annual Awards Banquet, James White and Teron Wings were honored as the Award of Excellence recipients. C&R Market was selected as Employer of the Year; Atkins was elected Partner of the Year: Don Moore was chosen as Employee of the Year; and, finally, Dr. Roger L. Morrison was acknowledged posthumously as Volunteer of the

Heart of Missouri United Way allocations provided skills training and placement services for high-risk older youth. As a funded partner, Job Point once again achieved Pacesetter status in its internal United Way employee campaign, with 100% eligible staff participation.

We purchased the building we have been renting, allowing the savings to go toward client services.

In collaboration with Missouri River Relief, YouthBuild/AmeriCorps students from St. Joseph and Kansas City joined Job Point in giving back to the community. Beyond the stewardship opportunity cleaning the Missouri River riverbed of litter and debris, the youth learned about wildlife and careers related to conservation.

Felicia Jackson-Qualls, Job Point Recruiter, participated in Leadership Columbia through the Chamber of Commerce.

The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) gave Job Point one of our best reviews ever. On an appraisal of 968 standards, we received only one recommendation. The CARF accreditation authorizes Job Point for the next three years and is necessary to receive funding from the Missouri Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Department of Mental Health.

> Joe Machens Dealerships not only sponsored the event, but took home the trophy as champion of our third annual Company Feud fundraiser. The event was a rousing success, leading to a night of laughter and over \$30,000 raised for Job Point.

Presented by Commerce Bank and Eng and Woods, the 31st Comedy Night Show raised over \$40,000 for Job Point. Fred DeMarco initiated the event over three decades ago and continues to lead it to this day. This year, Comedy Night will be held at Stoney Creek Hotel on April 29, 2020.

Columbia's City Council approved funding to further our affordable housing development initiative. These grant funds allowed Job Point to build two energy efficient homes at 7 & 9 Third Avenue. YouthBuild and Trades students are completing the work, and the houses will be sold to income-qualifying buyers with down payment assistance.

Job Point was honored to receive the Outstanding Community Champion of the Year Award from the Missouri Department of Transportation for our diverse and varied student population, particularly that of the Highway/Heavy Construction class. Many of these students have been placed into high-paying jobs, earning prevailing wage at \$40+/hr.

For the sixth year, Job Point participated in the CoMoGives campaign coordinated by the Community Foundation of Central Missouri. We thank our supporters for your holiday spirit and generous giving.

Nancy Silver, a 33 year veteran employee of Job Point, retired September 17th. Vice President for 23 years, Nancy was a vital member of Job Point's administrative team. Through her service, Nancy helped bring over \$25 million through grants and fundraisers to Job Point. Her influence extended to thousands of persons served with a disability. economic disadvantage or high-risk youth, as well as inspiring hundreds more staff and Board Members, interns, volunteers, funding partners and other business leaders.

In partnership with Job Point and Missouri Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, Shelter Insurance Companies, C&R Market and Randolph Area YMCA hosted high school students for a six-week Summer Work Experience Program. At Shelter Insurance, participants learned work-related skills by doing maintenance, detailing corporate vehicles, landscaping in Shelter Gardens and filing records. Students at C&R Market performed casheiring. bagging, stocking, food service and custodial duties.

At Randolph Area YMCA, students assisted with reception, maintenance, landscaping and child care. Additionally, students had the opportunity to attend seminars on work-related topics such as communication and problem-solving.
